

Professional Personnel Working Conditions

Electronic Communication Devices

Electronic communications devices, i.e., pagers, beepers, two-way radios, or cellular phones may not be used by employees in a way that would distract or interfere with instruction or guidance of students. Decisions regarding which employees need electronic communication devices during the performance of their regular duties will be made at the central office level and will be uniform throughout the system.

The use of any electronic communication device to conduct personal business while carrying out professional duties shall not be permitted.
