

Tuition**Students Residing in the State of Georgia Outside Muscogee County**

Unless otherwise excepted by law, all students residing in the State of Georgia outside of Muscogee County and attending the Muscogee County School District will be charged a tuition over the amount provided by the State Board of Education and the Board of Education of said County will certify to the State Board of Education that permission has been granted by said Board for such students to attend the Muscogee County School District.

Payment of Fees

Upon the payment of any fee by a student which is required by the Board of Education, the student shall be furnished with a receipt for fees and the money turned in promptly to the Treasurer's office.

Refund and Waiver of Fees

Nonresident fees shall not be refunded, unless the student becomes a resident of Muscogee County, at which time fees may be refunded on a pro rata basis. Students entering late are required to pay the pro rata part of nonresident fee. This rule shall be waived when it is in conflict with State and Federal regulations. The Superintendent of Schools is authorized to waive nonresident fees for students of parents employed by the district.

Students Residing Outside the State of Georgia

Students residing outside of the State of Georgia and attending the Muscogee County School District shall pay a nonresident tuition to cover the full cost of students attending the Muscogee County School District.

Care of Books and Instructional Materials

Students may write their names once on a blank leaf in each of their books, but their parents shall pay for other marks, defacements, or unnecessary injury.

Penalty for Abuse of Property

Parents of students who shall be guilty of defacing or injuring any of the school property

shall pay in full for all damage, and in default of such payment, students shall be suspended from school and not allowed to re-enter without permission from the principal. Under no condition will students be permitted to climb on school building to retrieve any object that has been thrown on the top of the building. Only authorized persons will be permitted on the roof of the school buildings in the district.
